Using Computers in School

- ✓ I will only access the computer system with the login and password I have been given
- ✓ I will not access other people's file
- ✓ I will not bring in memory sticks from home and use them in school equipment without permission
- ✓ I will treat school equipment with respect at all times

Using the Internet in School

- ✓ I will ask permission from an adult before using the internet
- ✓ I will report any unpleasant material immediately to protect myself and other pupils
- ✓ I understand that school may check my computer usage and sites visited
- ✓ I will not complete any online forms

(Children using the internet at home is at the discretion of parents however, the following section makes explicit that pupils have been made aware of responsible conduct in school)

Using the Internet at Home

- ✓ I understand an adult should be aware when I am accessing the internet
- ✓ I understand that I should only access sites or apps that adults know about
- I understand that social media has age limits for a reason and parents should be made aware of apps which have a social media facility
- I understand that using the internet for any unpleasantness outside of school may become a school conduct issue
- ✓ I know that I should only communicate online with people I know in the 'real world'
- ✓ I know I should not give information to or arrange to meet people I have 'met' on the internet
- ✓ I know that I should report any unpleasant material to an adult immediately to protect myself
- ✓ I know that I shouldn't share photographs of myself online or give information which could allow someone to identify me or acquire information about my location
- ✓ I know that any information I post online cannot be erased and I should consider what this may say about me and the impact this may have in years to come.
