<p><b>20%</b></p> <p>Use games/websites without parent knowledge</p>	<p><b>25%</b></p> <p>Have access to their parents' passwords</p>
<p><b>50%</b></p> <p>Download Apps without asking an adult</p>	<p><b>50%</b></p> <p>Wear headphones when online</p>
<p><b>20%</b></p> <p>Use website/games they are not allowed to use</p>	<p><b>20%</b></p> <p>Have been unkind when online</p>
<p><b>25%</b></p> <p>Say their parents don't know when they are online</p>	<p><b>40%</b></p> <p>Believe there are no settings on their technology to keep them safe.</p>
