## Topic

This half term, Romans will be our topic. Links will be made with other curriculum areas.

English: We will be reading the book 'The Turbulent Term of Tyke Tiler' with a focus on character development and settings. We will also have a focus on handwriting.

## Home Learning

The Homework sheet attached requires 3 pieces to be completed over this half term (one English, one maths and one science) as a minimum.

In addition, pupils are expected to learn the statutory spellings for their year group (you will find a list in their planners) across the year. To assist with this, pupils will be sent a weekly list. This is to help break down the rules into manageable chunks.  
It is also expected that pupils by Year 4 will be able to recite multiplication facts and the corresponding division facts up to 12x12. Any help at home with this, and reading is encouraged.

## Planners

We will use planners to access spelling lists and calendars. Please ensure it is in school every day. Please also make sure any book read, is recorded at the front. I will use this to ensure a range of reading material is covered by each pupil.

Maths: Alongside our work on learning the times tables, we are looking at place value and Roman numerals.

Science: We will be exploring teeth. How to keep them clean, the effect of different diets, and how they function.

Art and DT: We will create Roman mosaics using patterns and shape. Mr Mills will be working outdoors too.

RE and PSHCE: We will be setting ourselves goals and thinking about new beginnings. We will also be rehearsing our Harvest performance and asking 'Why do some people believe God exists?'

Computing: We will be learning how to keep ourselves safe using technology and using the internet to research.
