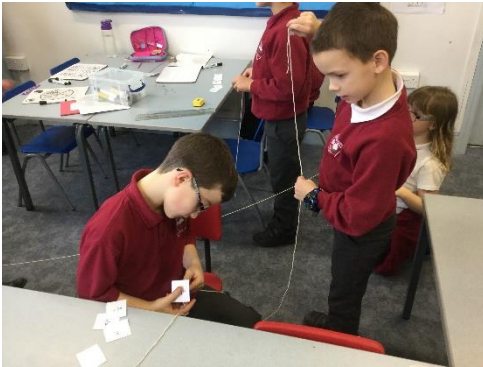
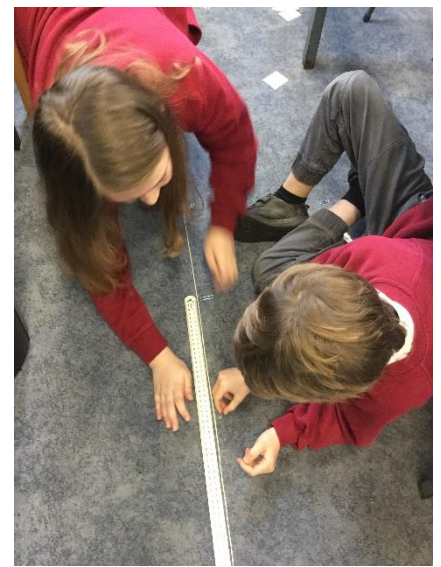
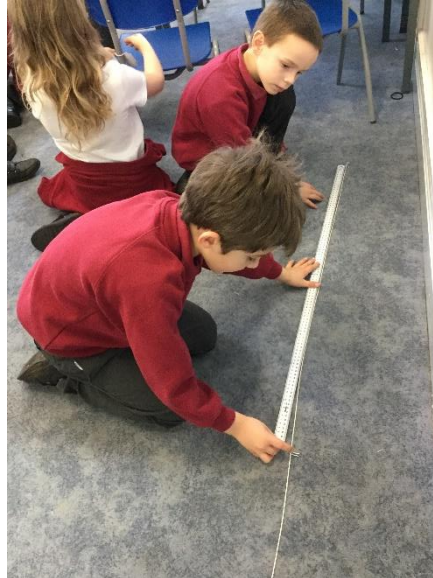

History – Chocolate Letters

In History, we have been debating the importance of the postal service in the First World War; was it worth all the money and labor?

We looked at letters from soldiers that were fighting in the war and discussed what primary sources can tell us about the past. The letters we looked at were thank you letters from Yorkshire regiments, sent to the Mayor and Sheriff of York in response to a Christmas gift of Rowntree chocolate that they had received, Christmas 1914.

English – Donate a Letter

Having explored different letters sent between soldiers and their loved ones, the children discussed how letters can bring such joy to the recipient.
